Shooting :

For 11 + 1 hour lunch or 10 hours CWD

Agreed rates

On Camera OT is chargeable in 15m increments for the first 2 hours and in 1hr increments thereafter.

per 15 minutes per 30 minutes

Off Camera OT is chargeable in 30m increments.

TOC is charged at 1.5T but is currently **CAPPED at £22.50 per half hour.**

Rigging :

For 9 hours + 1 hour lunch. No terms for CWD agreed** See below

Off Camera OT is charged in 30m increments.

TOC is charged at 1.5T but is currently **CAPPED at £22.50 per half hour.**

All of the rates quoted below are recommended rates and are based on a 5 day week. They are MINIMUM rates, therefore they do not exclude higher rates being reached by local negotiations.

Between £15-30 Million

For 11 + 1 hour lunch or 10 hours CWD

Recommended minimum rates

£347.90 **£1,740.00** **£63.25** **£47.44**
per day per week per hour per hour

There is no official agreement for rigging hours below the top rate films (£30 million +), however if a local agreement for rigging hours is reached for films between 15-30m the MINIMUM rate should be as follows:

Rigging :

For 9 hours + 1 hour lunch or CWD** See below

Recommended minimum rates

£299.90 **£1,500.00** N/A **£49.98**
per day per week per hour

The figures below have been reached by applying recent rate increases to the previously agreed 2011 rates. There are no agreed rigging hours or rates for these budget bands of Film so only the 11+ 1 or 10 CWD rates should be applied.

Below £15 Million

Shooting :

For 11 + 1 hour lunch or 10 hours CWD

Recommended minimum rates

£339.22 **£1,654.75** **£61.68** **£46.26**
per day per week per hour per hour

Below £5 Million

Shooting :

For 11 + 1 hour lunch or 10 hours CWD

Recommended minimum rates

£317.69 **£1,549.70** **£57.76** **£43.32**
per day per week per hour per hour

The OT rates of £50/£35 per hour are from 2011 which make them over 9 years old. They are outdated. As such we recommend you charge 2T for on camera OT and 1.5T for off camera OT

**Rigging crews CWD

If on the rare occasion rigging crews are required by Production to work a CWD, due to location issues or time constraints, we recommend that the universally accepted CWD rules should be applied (an 8 hr working day, 1 hour less than your normal working hours).

This must ALWAYS be agreed with Production before work starts, as there are no formally agreed CWD rigging hours.

For the avoidance of doubt: this CANNOT be applied if the rigging crew have decided amongst themselves to work through lunch- in this case the hours will officially remain at 9 working hours.

These rates represent a 2.5% payrise from the previous year.
