



## 2018 Lighting Technicians' Pay Increase

The below sets out the agreement reached between Pact and BECTU as approved by a ballot of lighting technicians:

- As of 1 April 2018, the rates for all shooting and rigging technicians shall increase by 2.5%. This will be implemented on all new productions, and on all productions that commenced before 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018. An increase of 2.5% is applicable for each year for the next three years.
- This rate increase applies to all Major Motion Pictures (which is defined as a production with a budget of £30m or more).
- The grades that currently negotiated their own rates and are excluded from this increase are: gaffers, rigging gaffers, HOD electrical riggers, desk ops and best boys. The position of HOD practical will be reviewed but are included in the 2018 2.5% increase. All other grades receive the increases detailed above.
- The increased daily rates are as follows:
