Potential funding for NVQ level 2 element of the Construction Industry Scaffolders Record Scheme (CISRS)

As you know The Joint Industry Grading Scheme (JIGS) and Joint Industry Scaffolding and Rigging Committee (JISRC) formerly known as SITAC oversees the film and television industry grading scheme for rigging.

JIGS and JISRC aim to ensure high safety standards and industry wide competence and are currently looking to align with The Construction Industry Scaffolders Record Scheme (CISRS).

JIGS and JISRC, working with the support of Train to Gain, the government workforce development funding initiative, and Skillset, are organising an event to inform members and operatives of funding which may be available for the National Vocational Qualification element and assessment element to achieve the CISRS card.

To achieve your CISRS Card, you need to undertake Part 1 Training, undergo 6 month's practical experience, then undertake Part 2 Training, followed by another 6 month's practical experience, then a final assessment. Without funding, typical costs for these are:

Part 1 training approximately £950 Part 2 training approximately £750 Final Assessment approximately £450

You may be eligible to get parts of this funded, or even all of it.

We strongly recommend that you take advantage of this event to help you achieve a CISRS card in order to support the increase of standards within the industry.
